THINK TALKS

Our very popular **THINK Talks** continue in 2021 with a series of talks given by specially invited speakers. Called on to be fresh, riveting and original, these speakers will ignite your curiosity and challenge your perspective on matters of substance, before responding to your comments and questions from the floor. With a similar format to TED Talks, this series will be sure to spark some crisp debate.

TIME FOR DISRUPTION IN THE FASHION INDUSTRY - A CIRCULAR ECONOMY

Speaker: Miriam Seifert – Masters of International Business.

Increases in purchasing and consumption habits have led to increases in waste and pollution around the world. Companies adopted a 'take, make and dispose' approach, which has led to unimaginable repercussions for society and environment. The concept of a circular economy or the regenerative economy provides a solution to some societal and environmental problems. Goods and materials are reused, recycled and upcycled to avoid goods ending up in landfills. Companies adopting a circular business model have demonstrated innovative strategies of reducing the environmental impact of goods.

Tuesday 23 February 7:30pm - 8:30pm

DEMOCRACY IN THE 21ST CENTURY

Speaker: Timothy Kuhner – Associate Professor, University of Auckland Faculty of Law.

Government by the people is under threat, even here in New Zealand. Rising inequality, political distrust, rampant corruption, authoritarianism, and climate change threaten political communities world-wide. Why are democracies performing so poorly? How are these problems manifesting locally? What can people here and abroad do to revitalize democracy, and ensure a brighter future? This lecture addresses the underlying causes of democratic decline and proposes a series of reforms that would ensure greater integrity.

Tuesday 16 March 7:30pm - 8:30pm

NEW APPROACHES TO TREATING DEPRESSION

Speaker: Dr Suresh Muthukumaraswamy – PhD in Psychology.

Depression is one of the leading causes of disability in the world. Current treatments for depression are hampered by only limited effectiveness and slow onset of response. Recently new therapies have emerged that have shown promise for many patients who suffer from this disorder. Some of these therapies include transcranial magnetic stimulation, ketamine and psychedelics for depression and various types of talking and exercise therapy. Science is only just beginning to understand how some of these therapies can be combined for optimal patient outcomes.

Tuesday 13 April 7:30pm - 8:30pm

VIRTUAL REALITY IN HEALTHCARE

Speaker: Dr Lisa Reynolds – Health Psychologist and Director of the University of Auckland's Health Psychology Practitioner Programme.

Virtual reality experiences have potential to transform the patient experience of health care and rehabilitation. In this talk, Dr Reynolds will discuss the current use and future potential of virtual reality experiences in health care. She will also present findings from her recent research which found that virtual nature experiences in women who have advanced breast cancer offer benefits to psychological and physical well-being.

Tuesday 1 June 7:30pm - 8:30pm

EMOTION REGULATION, RELATIONSHIPS AND WELL-BEING

Speaker: Dr Rachel Low – Assistant Professor/Lecturer of Psychology, at Auckland University of Technology (AUT).

In this talk, Dr Low will first discuss the different ways people manage or control their emotions during emotionally challenging situations, with a specific focus on social interactions. She will also talk about how emotion regulation within intimate relationships shapes the degree to which individuals can successfully achieve personal goals, and how well couples can resolve their disagreements. Finally, she will discuss how parents' conflict can spill over to parent-child relationships within the family environment.

Tuesday 22 June 7:30pm - 8:30pm

CHINESE NATIONALISM AND FOREIGN POLICY IN THE ASIA-PACIFIC

Speaker: Joseph Miller – Completing a PhD in Asian Studies at the University of Auckland.

There is a common concern that Chinese nationalism under Xi Jinping affects China's foreign policy, but debate exists as to the exact nature of the relationship. To what extent does it influence policy, and what can be expected from it? This talk will examine the connections between the two, outlining China's main foreign policy strategies in the Asia-Pacific and the role nationalism plays in China's behaviour. Joseph will offer his own analysis of the situation and some takeaways for Aotearoa New Zealand's own relationship with China, based on his doctoral research on the subject.

Tuesday 6 July 7:30pm - 8:30pm

MIND OVER MEDICINE: THE POWER OF THE PLACEBO AND NOCEBO EFFECT

Speaker: Kate MacKrell – Intern Psychologist at the Department of Psychological Medicine, University of Auckland.

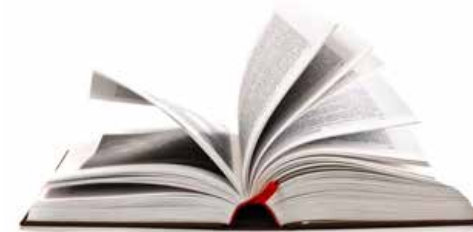

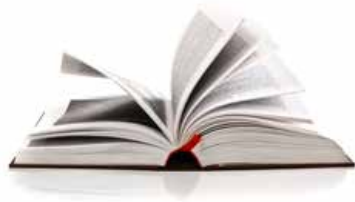

To minimise the risk of damage, employees and students should ensure that their personal property is secured, preferably in alarmed areas, and that vehicles are parked in allocated parking spaces.

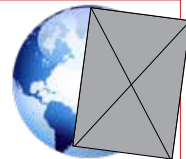


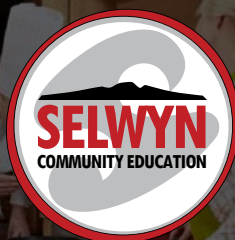

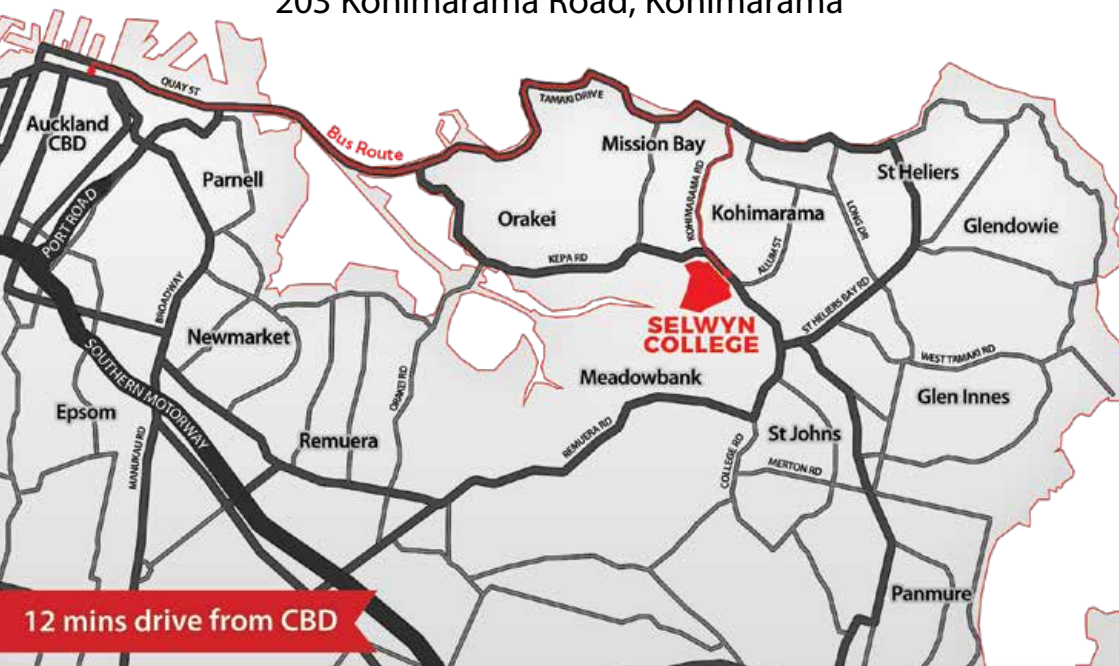
